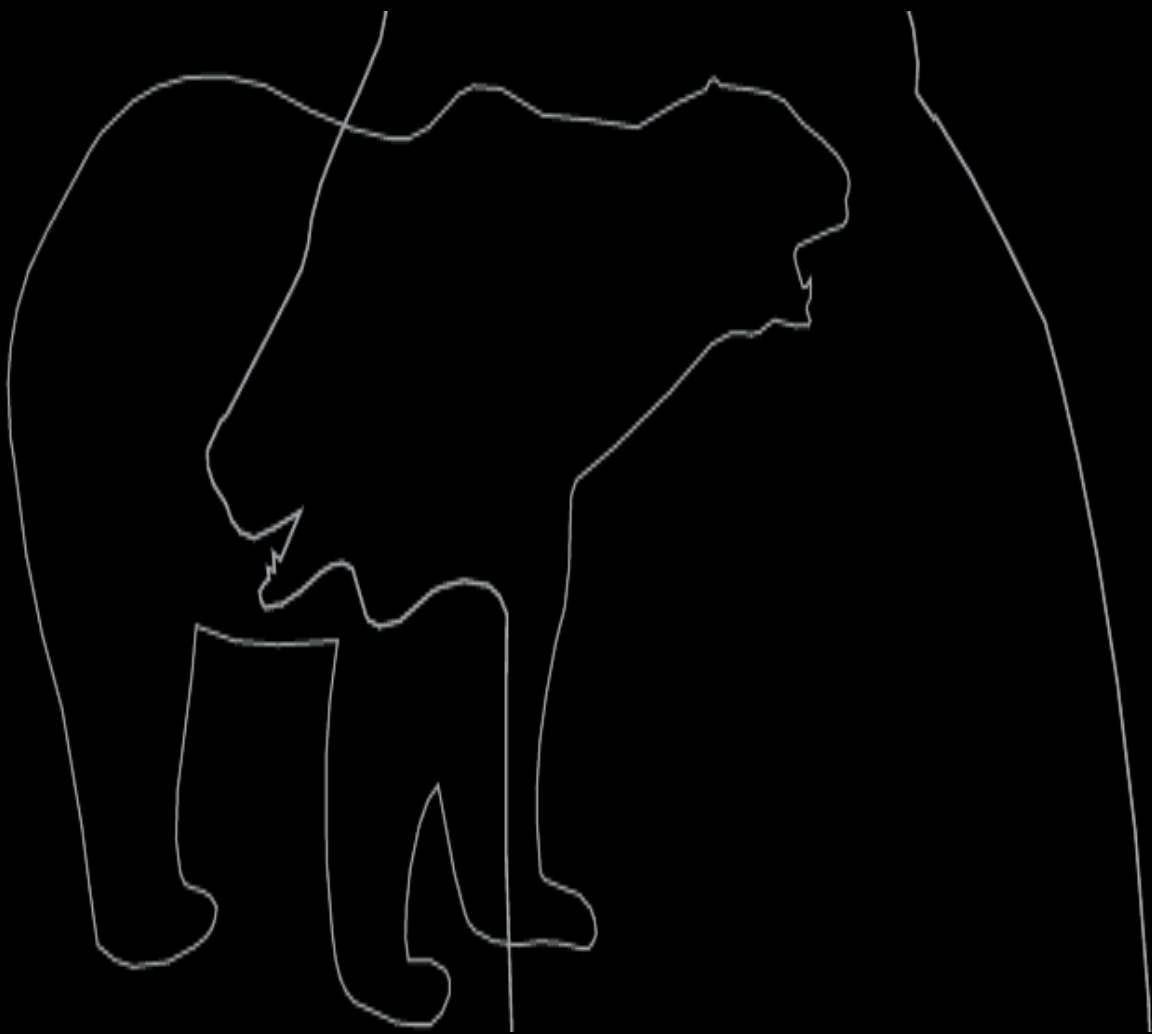


A Night with the Bears
